The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined video and data evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor: INTER EUROPOL COMPETITION
Session: Race
Time (fact): 00:19
Fact: Alleged failure to maintain a gap of five car lengths during the Safety Car procedure.
Offence: Alleged breach of Art. 14.6.1 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations
Decision: No further action

Reason:

After reviewing the CCTV footage and data, the Stewards determined that, while the gap between the cars varied, this was a consequence of the restart following the Safety Car period and the respective actions of the cars as they progressed through the braking zones, corners and acceleration zones, all of which naturally affected the gaps between them.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that no breach of the regulations had occurred and therefore decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
