The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

Fact: Alleged contact between cars 83 and 35 at MP3
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action

Reason:

Having reviewed the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 83 attempted to overtake Car 35 on the inside at MP3. Car 35 was committed to the corner and slight contact occurred between the two cars at the apex. Following the contact, Car 83 experienced a slide but successfully regained control of the car without any further consequence. Both cars were able to continue.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that neither driver was predominantly at fault and that the contact should therefore be regarded as a racing incident. The Stewards decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
