The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Reason:

Having reviewed the video evidence and heard the drivers and Team Managers, the Stewards determined that Car 34 attempted to overtake Car 54 on the inside at Turn 1 and made contact with Car 54, causing Car 54 to spin.

During the hearing, the Stewards, the Competitors' Representatives and the Drivers reviewed the 3 CCTV videos from the circuit and the onboard camera of car 34. The driver of Car 34, Salih Yoluç, acknowledged that he had made contact with Car 54, explaining that he believed there had been a misunderstanding between the two drivers.

The Stewards noted that, on the approach to Turn 1, Car 54 had initially moved aside to allow another car to pass before subsequently turning into the corner. The Stewards accepted that the driver of Car 34 may reasonably have interpreted this movement as leaving space for him to overtake on the inside, which ultimately resulted in the contact between the two cars.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that the driver of Car 34 was predominantly at fault for the contact. As the incident occurred during a Free Practice session, the Stewards decided to impose a Reprimand on the driver of Car 34.

According to Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and the article 7.4.6 of 24 hours of WEC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
