The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter :

**N° / Driver:** 87 / Clemens SCHMID  
**Competitor:** AKKODIS ASP TEAM  
**Session:** Hyperpole LMGT3  
**Time (fact):** 14:57  
**Fact:** Alleged impeding of car 61 during a fast lap in Qualifying session  
**Offence:** Alleged breach of App.L, chap.IV, 2b) of International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** No further action

**Reason:**

After reviewing the video evidence and data from both cars, and having heard the Team Representatives and the drivers, the Stewards determined that the driver of Car 61 alleged that Car 87 had impeded him at the end of one lap and again at the start of the following lap.

The driver of Car 87 explained that he had deliberately increased his speed at the end of the first lap in question to avoid impeding the following car and had maintained that pace into the next lap, which was also a fast lap for him.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that there was insufficient evidence to establish that Car 87 had impeded Car 61. The Stewards therefore decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
