The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

N° / Competitor: 83 / AF CORSE
Session: Before the start of the race
Time (fact): 10:23
Fact: The Car Controller moved onto the blending lane before the race.
Offence: Alleged breach of article 12.2.1.i of FIA ISC - Briefing notes presentation
Decision: No further Action

Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that the Car Controller of Car 83 stepped from the concrete onto the asphalt and then into the blending lane. The Stewards noted that the Car Controller initially released the car and was standing correctly on the concrete. However, a team member of the adjacent pit box momentarily stood in front of car 83. Once the person had moved, the driver of car 83 moved forward, however by then Car 93 was approaching in the fast lane. To avoid a potential collision, the Car Controller of car 83 stepped into the Blending Lane to hold car 83 until Car 93 had passed. The Stewards determined that the Car Controller had initially respected the extent of the working lane and had only stepped out to avoid a collision.

Considering the matter extensively, the Stewards therefore decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
