The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Competitor: TEAM WRT
Session: Race
Time (fact): 12:52
Fact: Alleged contact between cars 32 and 91 at T2.
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action

Reason:

Having reviewed the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Cars 32 and 91 were fighting for position. Car 32 overtook Car 91 at Turn 1 but lost the position again on the exit of Turn 1. During the manoeuvre, slight contact occurred between the two cars.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that the incident was a racing incident, with neither driver being predominantly at fault. The Stewards therefore decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
