The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, summoned from the Competitor's Representative and the Driver concerned, having examined the video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 93 / Stoffel VANDORNE
Competitor: PEUGEOT TOTALENERGIES
Session: FP3
Time (fact): 11:08
Fact: Allegedly driving unnecessarily slowly on the racing line before and at T 20.
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Art. 2e) of International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

Having reviewed the video evidence and telemetry data, the Stewards determined that, on the approach to Turn 20, Car 93 reduced speed while positioned on the right-hand side of the track before moving to the left. The Stewards noted that the cars ahead of Car 93 also reduced speed, requiring Car 93 to reduce his speed accordingly.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that Car 93 was not driving unnecessarily slowly or in an erratic manner. The Stewards determined that the situation arose from a misunderstanding between the drivers and therefore decided to take no further action.

Nevertheless, the Stewards remind all Competitors to avoid remaining on the racing line when not on a push lap.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
