The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, summoned from the Competitor' Representative and the Driver concerned, having examined the video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 50 / Nicklas NIELSEN
Competitor: FERRARI AF CORSE
Session: Race
Time (fact): 15:22
Fact: Allegedly moving under braking at T 11.
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Art. 2e) of International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

Having reviewed the available video evidence and telemetry data, and having considered the circumstances of the incident, the Stewards determined that Car 50 and Car 8 approached Turn 11 under braking with both cars following a similar trajectory and with the same steering wheel angle.

The telemetry data confirmed that neither car made any significant change of direction under braking and that both cars maintained a consistent steering input throughout the relevant phase of the corner.

Having considered all the available evidence, the Stewards were unable to attribute responsibility for the contact to either driver. The Stewards therefore determined that the incident was a racing incident and decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
