The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, have considered the following matter:

Decision: 2 minutes Stop and Go penalty

Reason:

Having reviewed the available evidence and the reports concerning the repeated track limit infringements, the Stewards noted that the driver had already received several warnings and had previously been given two Drive-Through Penalties.

Despite these warnings and penalties, the driver continued to commit further track limit infringements. The 7th, 8th and 9th infringements occurred within a very short period of time.

Considering the frequency and proximity of these infringements, as well as the two Drive-Through Penalties already imposed, the Stewards considered it appropriate, in the specific circumstances of this case, to combine these three infringements for the purpose of determining a single penalty, in order to avoid several successive passages through the pit lane within a very short period of time.

The Stewards therefore decided to impose a single penalty reflecting the cumulative nature of the three infringements.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 7.4.2 of 2026 WEC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
